Visit to the National Museum of the Royal Navy Portsmouth

Rosanne has arranged a SoFFAAM group visit to this exceptional museum in Portsmouth and if you would like to join us, please read on.

This visit is taking place on Wednesday 28 May 2025 and Coach Transport is arranged from The Fleet Air Arm Museum to Portsmouth and return. Arrive at the Museum Car Park, where you can leave your car, for 8:15am and we will leave at 8:30am sharp, please do not be late. We aim to return to the Museum Car Park around 6:00pm.

There are extensive collections to visit at this facility namely, **The** *Mary Rose*, a one-of-a-kind attraction that

brings you closer to Tudor life than you can imagine. **HMS Victory** (though a major refurbishment is currently underway), **HMS Warrior**, the crown jewel of the Victorian Navy. The **National Museum of the Royal Navy** where you can discover the real story of the Royal Navy over the last 350 years. **M33**, one of the last surviving First World War ships still in existence. **Boathouse 4**, where you can step inside and embark on a journey through years of boat building history

Our special group ticket allows each individual to enter **3 of the above ships and exhibits** so choose wisely which 3 you want to see.

The Museum facility is spaced over a large area with no other options but to walk between the exhibits you choose to visit. Being historic buildings and ships can mean challenges for some visitors. But there is a ramp up onto HMS *Warrior* and there is wheelchair access to *Victory's* lower Gun Deck.
