The staff will demonstrate how they care for the items held in its collection stores. This tour will not include the Aero Hall. **Barracuda Live:** The session will cover a project update presentation in the Auditorium about this ambitious and unique rebuild project to create the world's only example of a Fairey Barracuda Torpedo Dive Bomber.
