



Visit to Antiqua Ships at Coates English Willow Visitor Centre, on Wednesday 21 October

This is a 'self drive' visit to Antiqua Ships on **Wednesday 21 October** who are based at the Coates English Willow Visitor Centre, Meare Green Court, Stoke St Gregory, Taunton TA3 6HY.

Antiqua is an artisan workshop providing repair, restoration and preservation of antique or collectable models of ships, boats or other maritime craft. The workshop is home to a small gallery and an equally small but specialist collection of out-of-print maritime books. The cost is just **£15.00** per person and guests are welcome. Includes are coffee and biscuits before the visits in the Lemon Tree Cafe. You can also have breakfast here or lunch at your own expense.

Due to the size of the workshop we have been asked to split into two groups. First group to arrive at 10:15 at Lemon Tree Cafe to be greeted by Allan McGreal. The tour will be completed by 12:15 where you can stay for lunch or visit the other units and museum on site.

Second group to arrive for 12:45, and meet at the Lemon Tree cafe for coffee, followed by the tour starting at 13:30 and finishing around 14:45.
